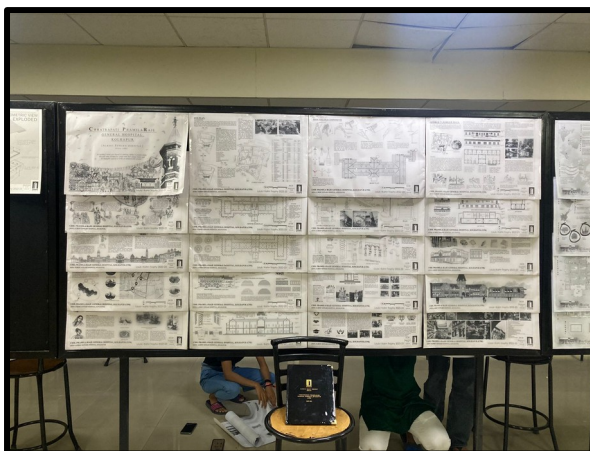
ANNUAL EXHIBITION

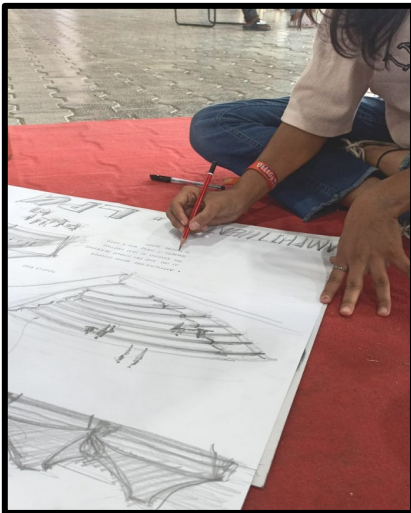
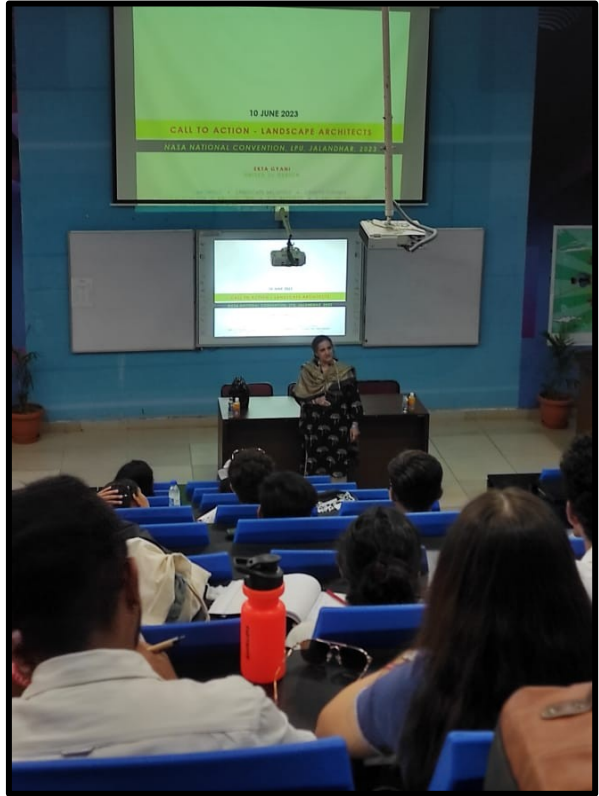
ANNUAL NASA CONVENTION (ANC) 65th YEAR 2022-23
